Each week will be educational as we cover a specific phase of the trauma resolution modality (a demo of the material with a participant might also be included depending on the week's material). There will be an optional opportunity to practice the skills learned that week with another participant in a 1-on-1 practice pod.

- Working precisely with Milieus or Sustained Experiences and Significant Relationships or Single Events
- How and when to selectively use psychoactive substances as an accelerator
- The Shadow of substance assisted psychotherapy
- Introducing the Unified Psychosocial (UP) Framework
- The DeMause Psychosocial Modes/Empathetic Capacity Levels
- Working with Trauma Clusters: Culling, Resource Wedging, Dipping
- Working with Traumatic Transference and Traumatic Reenactment
- Relational Containment and In-Group Traumas
- A Primer on Attachment Work with Sustained Eye-Contact
